### Reptile

<u>Locomotion</u>	<u>Definition</u>	<u>Example</u>
Run	Use legs to move quickly	Lizards
Walk	Use legs to move on land	Lizards, Tortoises
Swim	Use tails/fins/flippers to move	Lizards, Turtles
Dive	Go to the bottom of water	Crocodilians, Turtles
Climb	Use legs to raise body	Lizards, Crocodilians
Float	Remain on top of water	Tortoises
Crawl	Use legs to move slowly	Tortoises
Slither	Use muscles to move	Snakes
Paddle	Use fins/flippers	Turtles
Leap	Use legs to jump from place to place	Lizards, Crocodilians

### Mammal

<u>Locomotion</u>	<u>Definition</u>	<u>Example</u>
Run	Use two legs to move quickly	Primates
Walk	Use legs to move on land	Primates
Swim	Use appendages to move in water	Whales, Dolphins, Us
Canter	Use four legs to move quickly	Zebra, Giraffe, etc.
Brachiate	Move arms in 180 degrees to move	Primates
Swing	Use arms to move	Primates
Leap	Use arms to jump/pounce	Predators,
Dive	Go to bottom of water	Whales, Dolphins, Us
Climb	Use appendages to raise body	Land mammals
Float	Remain on top of water	Whales, Us
Crawl	Use appendages to move slowly	Us
Paddle	Use appendages to move in water	Whales, Dolphins, Us
Hop	Use feet to jump small distances	Rabbits

### Bird

<u>Locomotion</u>	<u>Definition</u>	<u>Example</u>
Walk	Use legs to move on land	All
Swim	Use appendages to move in water	Penguins
Dive	Go to bottom of water	Ducks
Float	Remain on water surface	Ducks
Paddle	Use webbed feet to move in water	Most all
Hop	Use feet ot jump small distances	Most all
Fly	Use wings to move through air	Most all
